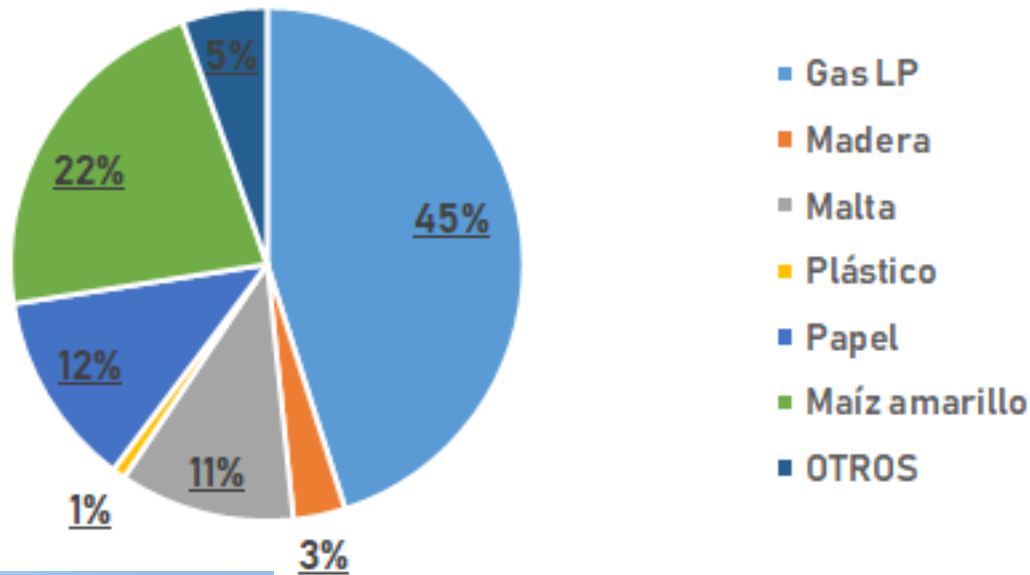

PARTICIPACIÓN POR COMMODITY 2018

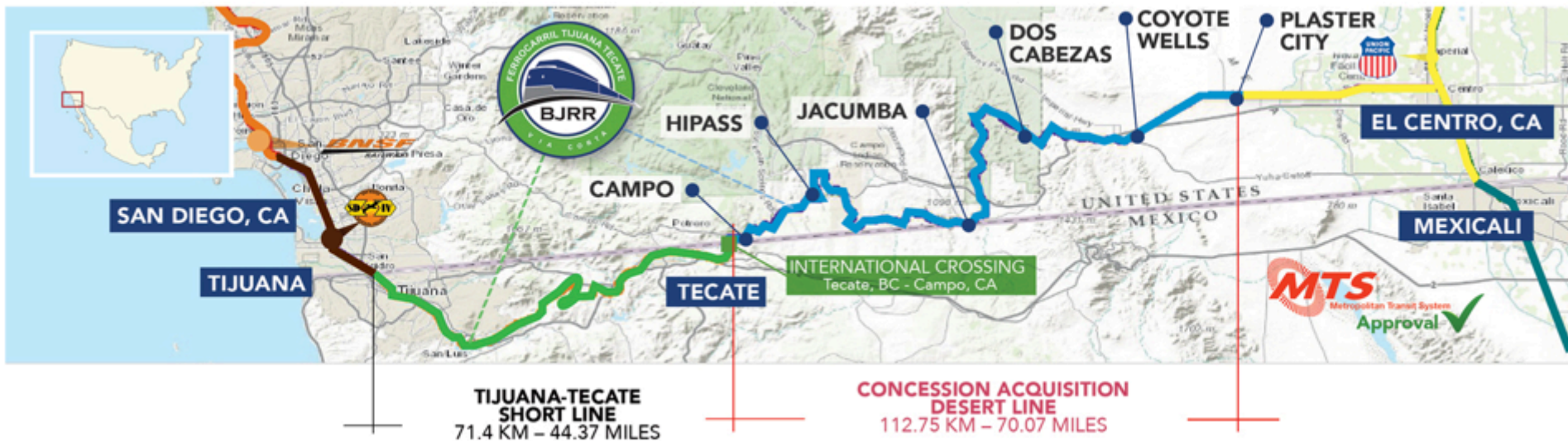




# DESERT LINE

## CONCESSION ACQUISITION UPDATE

- MTS and BJRR sign a 99 year lease agreement.
- BJRR determines to include an Environmental Committee for permit supervision.
- Negotiations take place with US & MX Port authorities to determine location and specs of each facility.

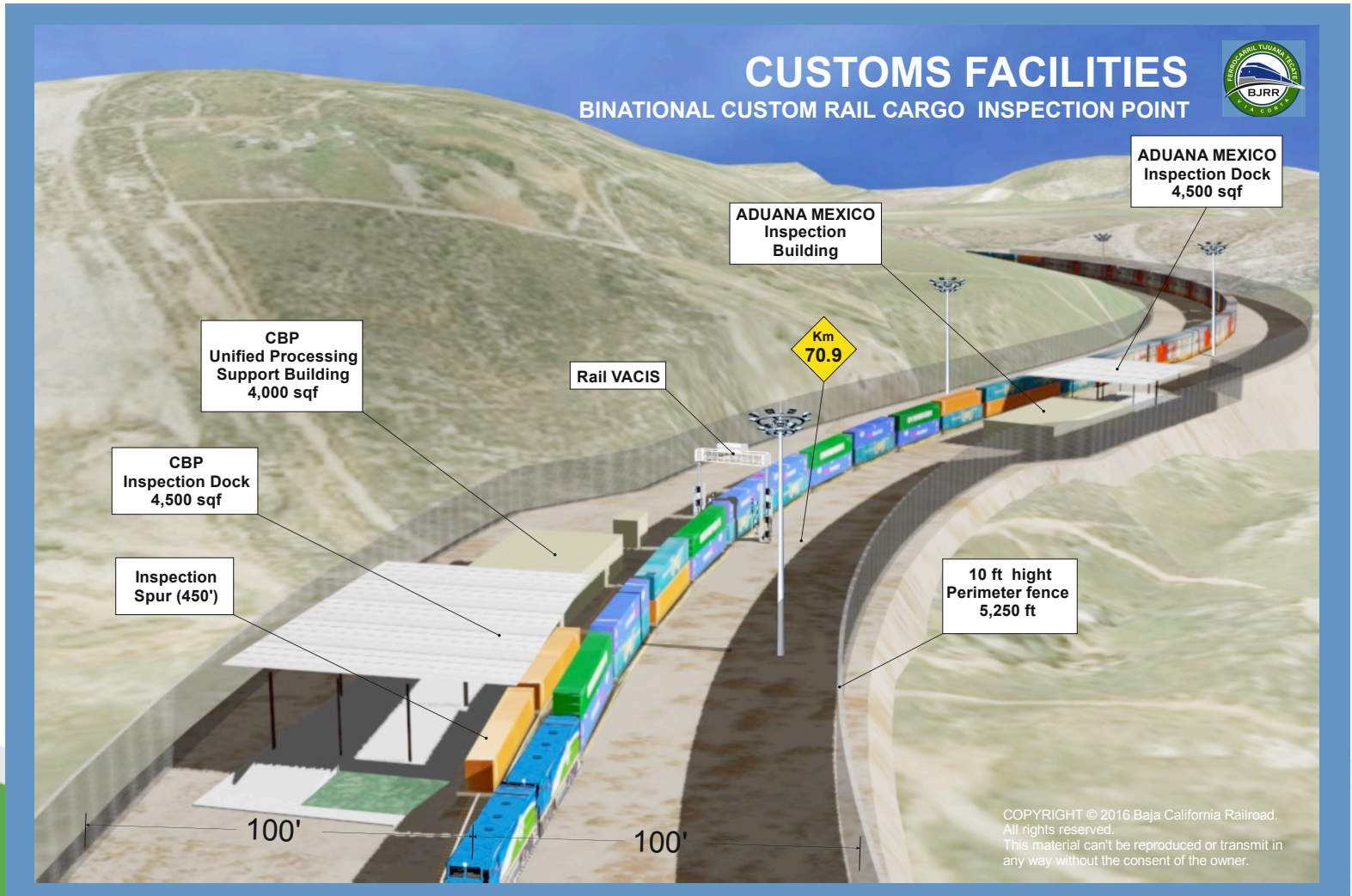
