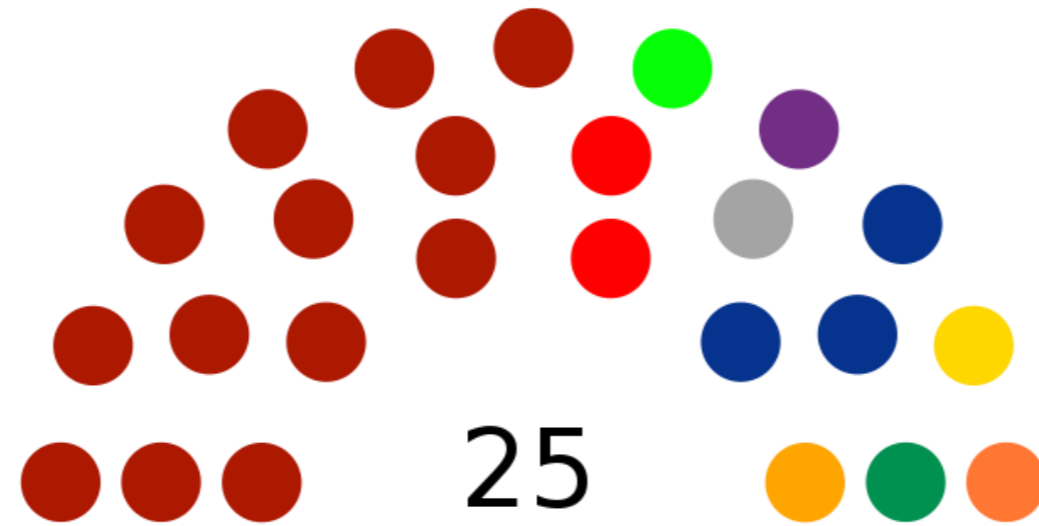

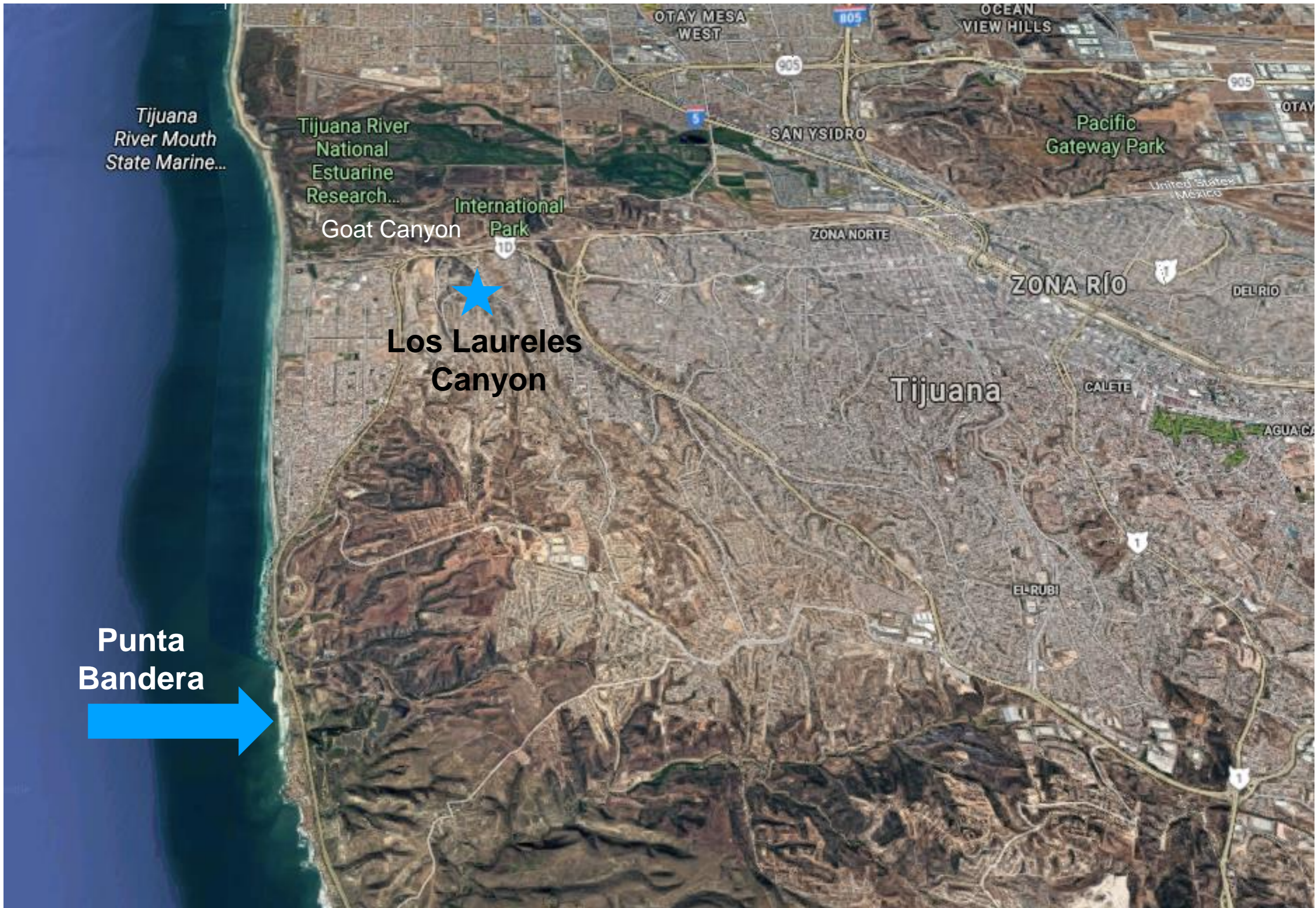

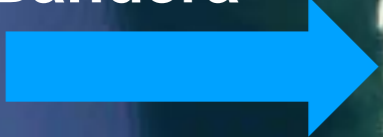

Goat Canyon spills...black tea?

"Not like last month when it came through red."

Border Patrol agents were surprised Wednesday morning (March 1) to see black water pouring through the grates over a drainage tube at the southeast edge of Goat Canyon.

"It was like really black tea, literally black water," one agent said. "Not like last month when it came through red."

The International Boundary and Water Commission is having the liquid tested to see what it is, but suspects it was contaminated by black paint or dye, according to a statement from the commission.

INITIATIVE TO REFORM THE PENAL CODE OF THE STATE OF BAJA CALIFORNIA

- ❖ The crime of ECOCIDE is to be recognized and, with it, establishes tougher sentences in such a way, that done intentionally, those who cause severe damage to the environment by emitting contaminants, undertaking risky activities or affecting natural resources can face up to 12 years in prison.
- ❖ Furthermore, civil servants seen to be involved in criminal acts, directly or indirectly, will be disqualified from holding any government position.





REFORM OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LAW OF THE STATE OF BAJA CALIFORNIA

The Government will be required to monitor the quality of the water on our coasts and rivers, as well as the air quality in the cities of the state.

- ❖ The Environmental Protection Secretary must publish those results at least every two weeks on its webpage.

THE METROPOLITAN COORDINATION LAW

- The process of metropolitization has not been accompanied by a legal framework that permits the designing and application of efficient planning and coordination instruments.
- In May of 2017 “The Challenges of Metropolitan Development” was held which gave the result, in March of 2018, of the presenting of the bill to reform articles 27, 83 and 84 of the Constitution of the state of Baja California.

- **The Metropolitan Coordination Board:** It is an intercity political coordination body made up of the corresponding mayors and the state governor. The board has a technical secretary that performs executive functions and is the director of the corresponding institute. The presidency of the board rotates among the city mayors.
- **The Metropolitan Planning Institute:** It is a decentralized public, intercity agency whose objective is to coordinate the planning of the metropolitan area and technically supports the Metropolitan Coordination Board. It is lead by a director and made up of administrative units that establish the corresponding statutes.
- **Metropolitan Citizen Council:** It is an intercity consulting body with citizen involvement, being honorary. It is made up of citizen representatives of the HOAs and other civil associations, professional and academic.
- **Planning Advisory Council:** It is a collegiate body made up of the representatives of the municipal government in the Metropolitan area, of the state government, of the Metropolitan Planning Institute or other agencies and entities of the federal government, national or international, including amongst intercities. He always gives technical support, to the instances of the Metropolitan Planning Institute in planning, promotion and metropolitan management of the development. Legally forming in the institutional link and orchestrating the execution of the Metropolitan policy.
