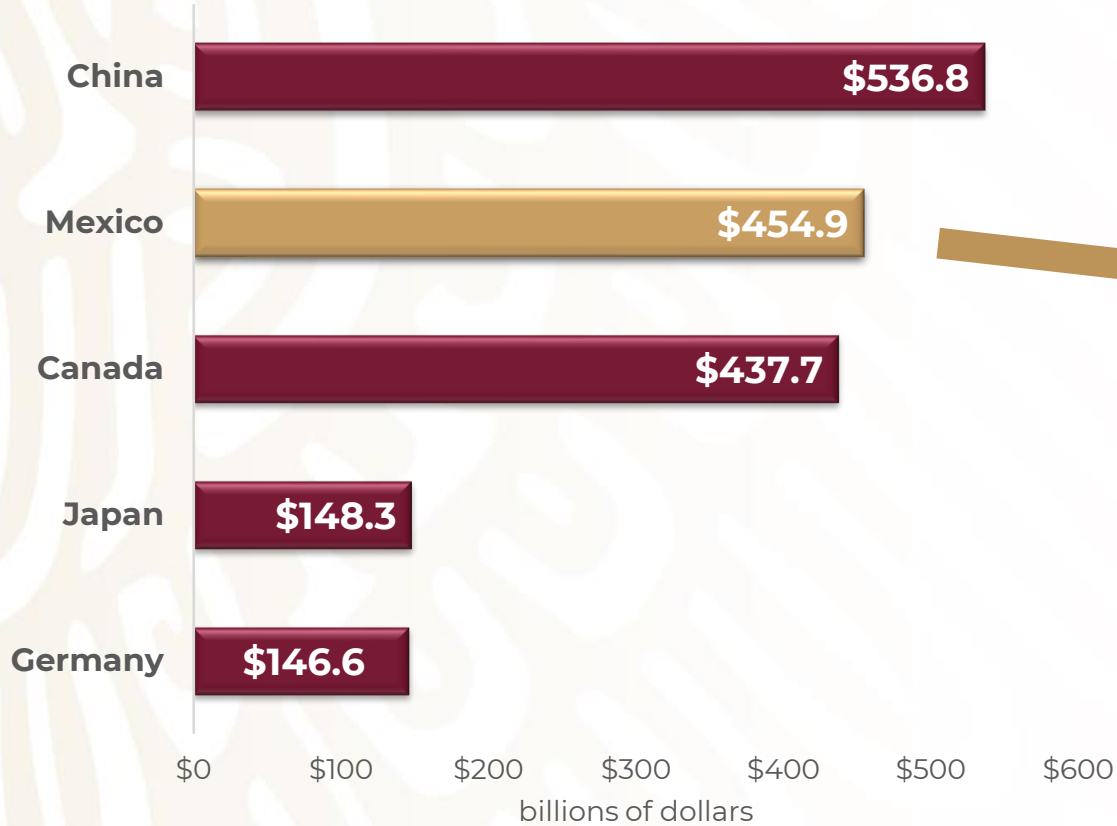

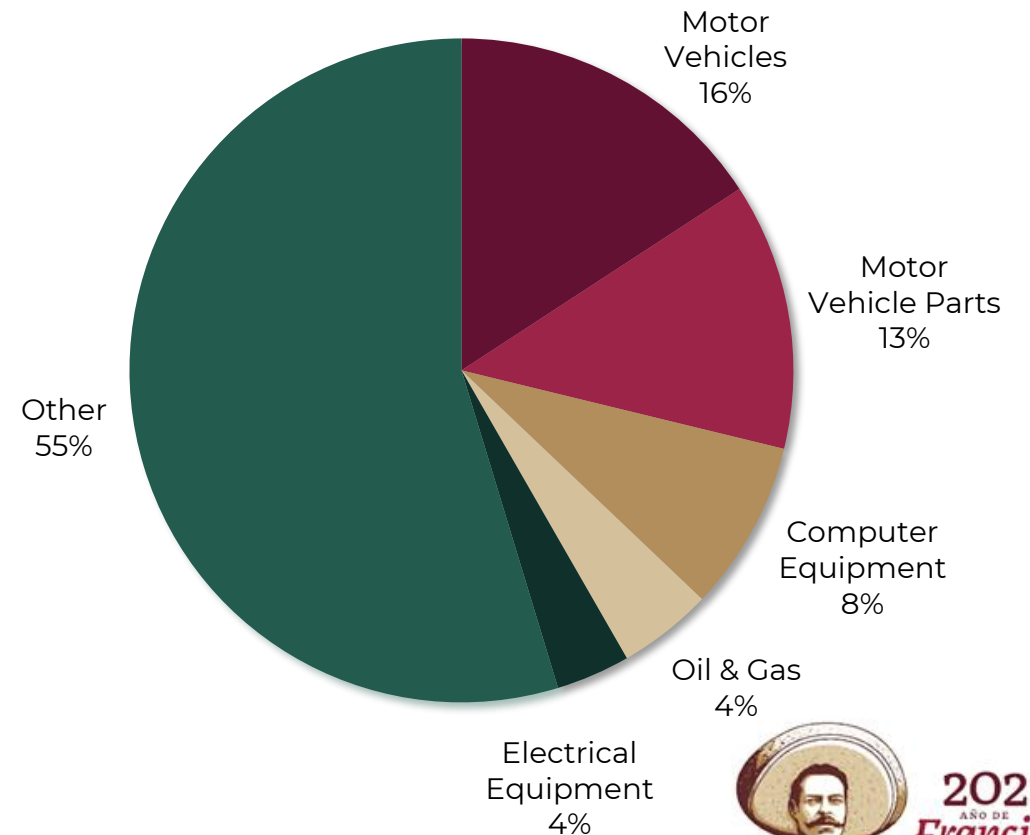

U.S. imports from Mexico 2022

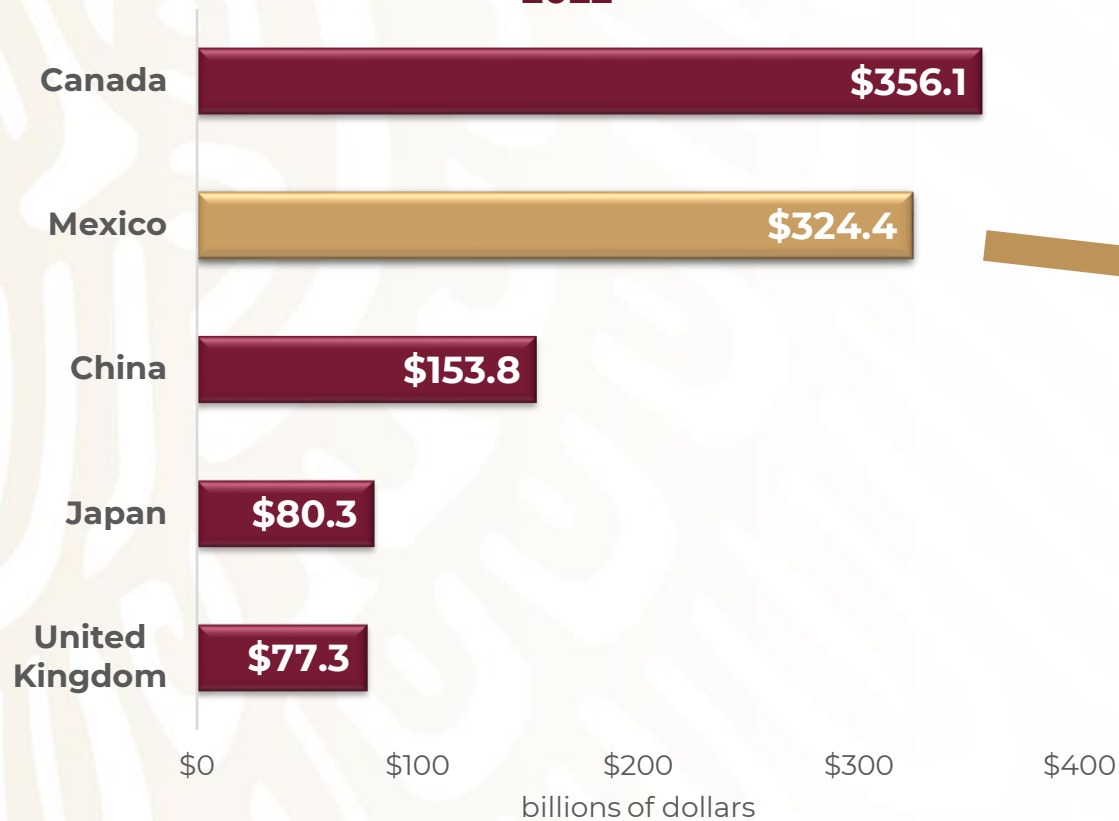

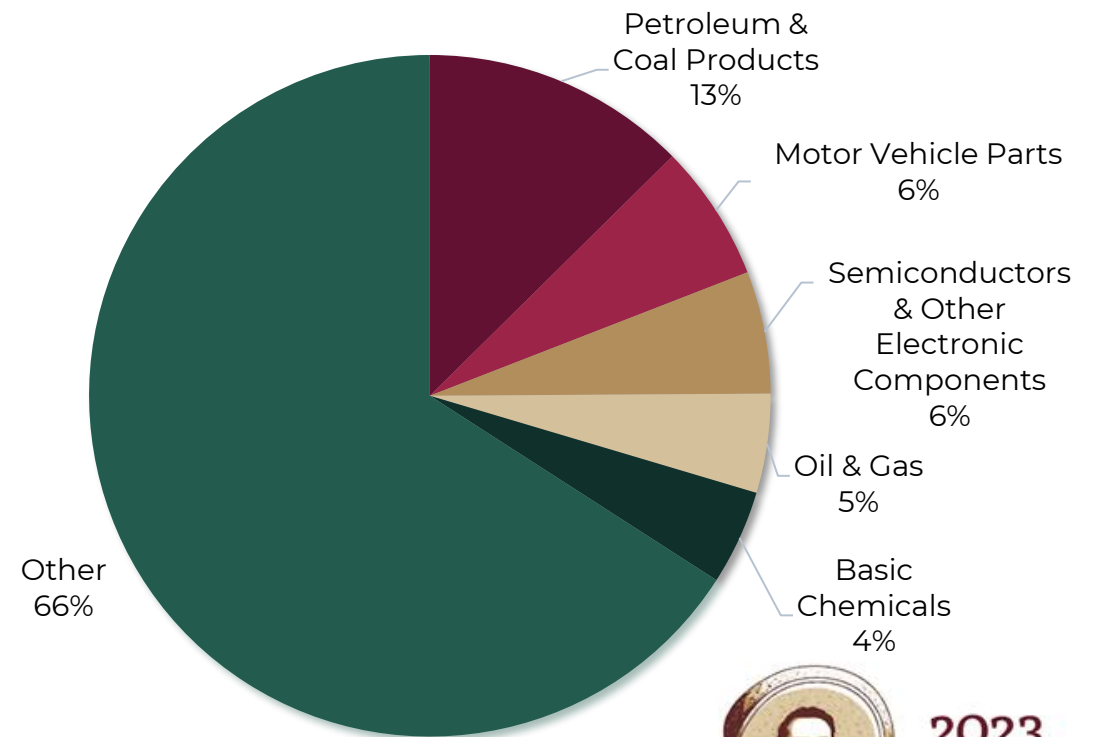


Mexico is the United States' 2nd largest buyer of goods

U.S. exports to Mexico 2022

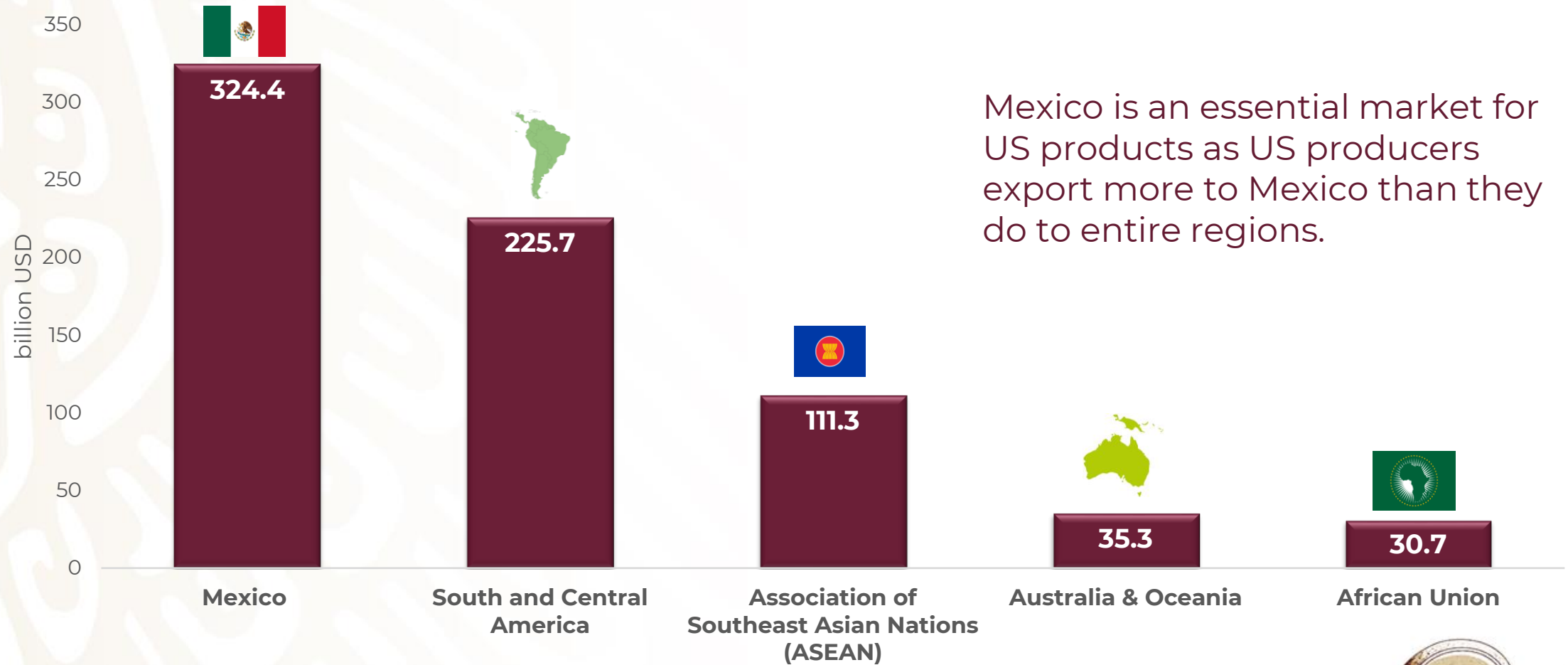

U.S. Exports to Selected Destinations

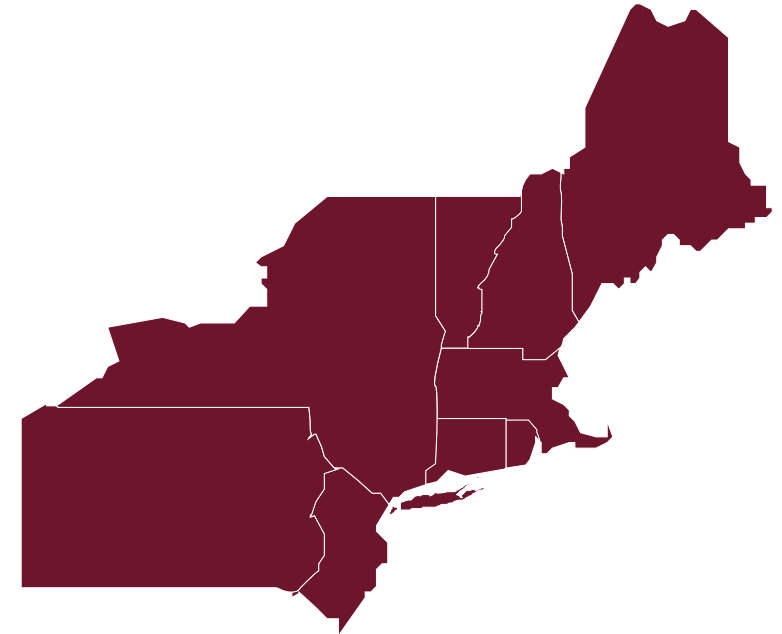

Trade between Mexico and the Northeast

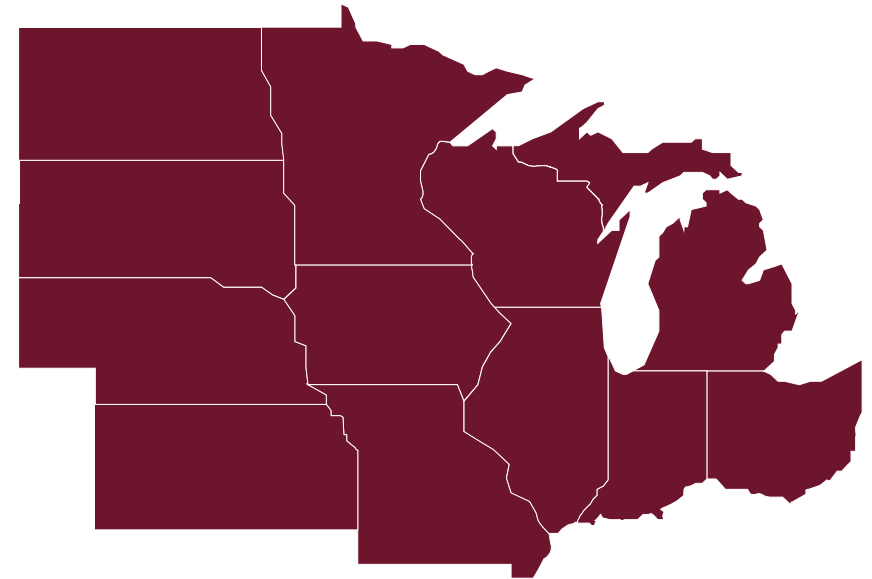

Trade between Mexico and the Midwest

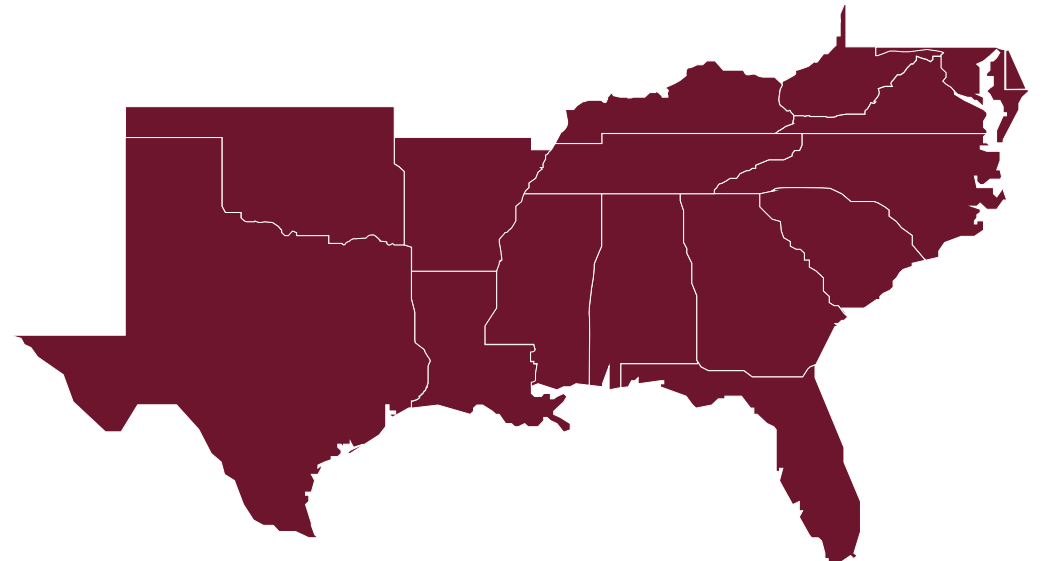

The Midwest's trade with Mexico is larger than the U.S.' trade with Italy, Spain, and Portugal combined.

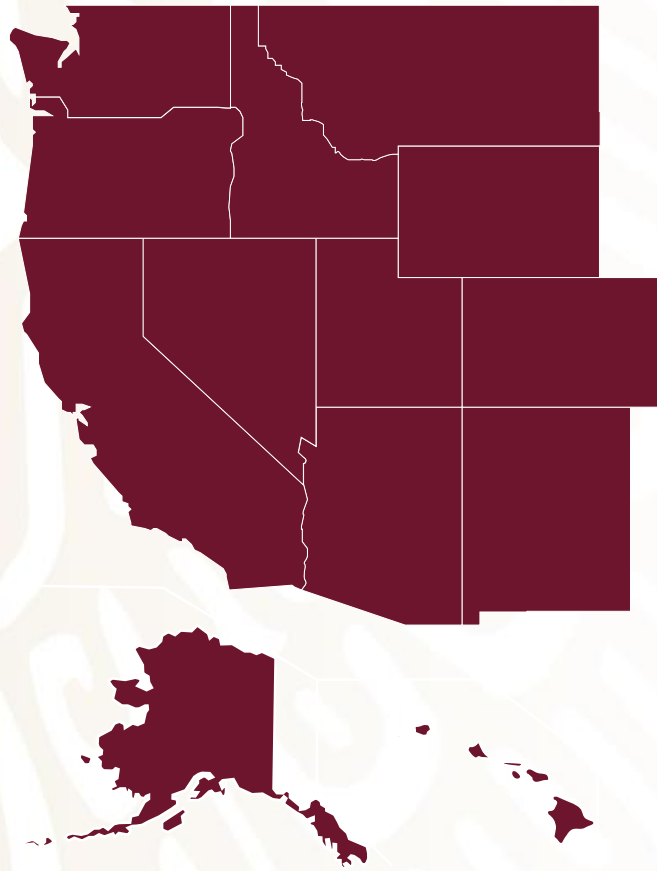
Trade between Mexico and the South

The South's trade with Mexico is larger than the U.S.' trade with all of South and Central America combined.

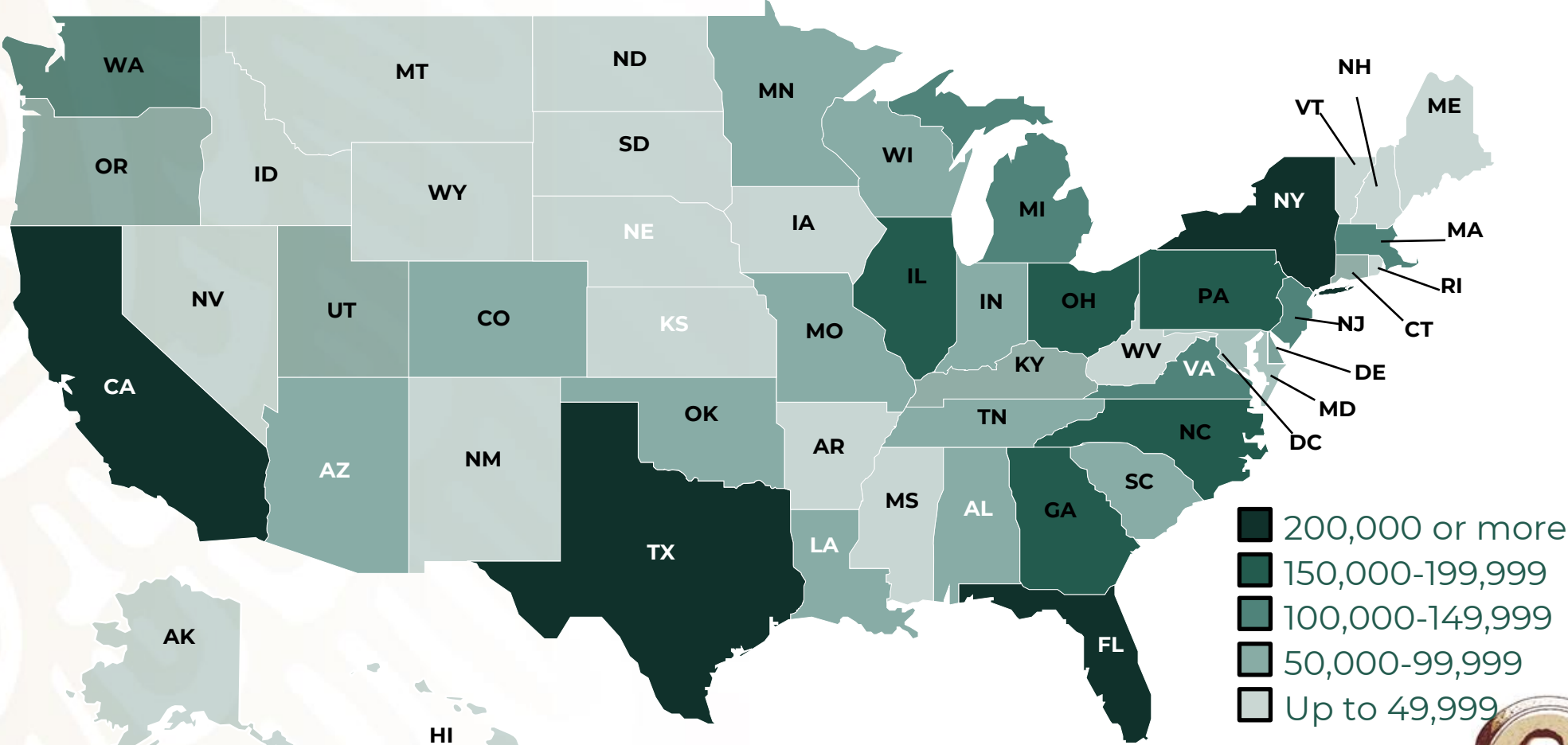
Trade between Mexico and the West
